Not keen on traditional academia? No problem! NextGen offers tailored support to steer you towards alternative avenues.

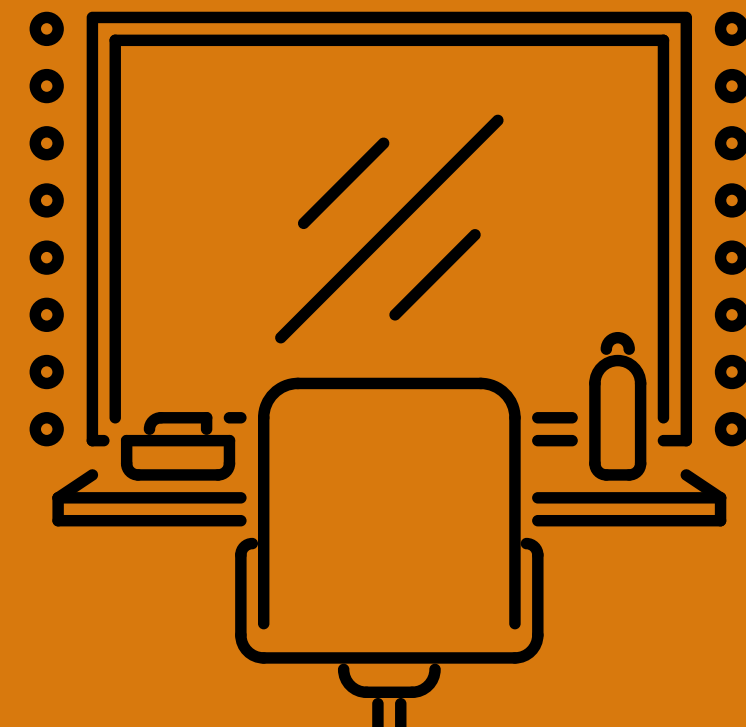
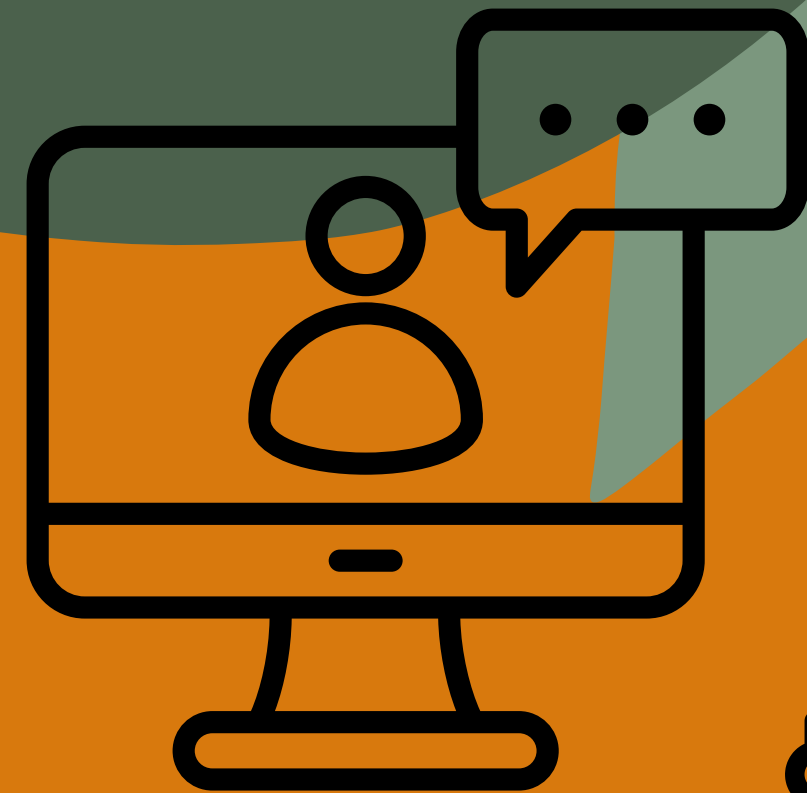
### Trade School Scholarships:

- Age 16-24
- Not Attending High School or College **AND**
- You are parenting or expecting a baby **or**
- involved in the justice system **or**
- Has not worked in the past 6 months **or**
- Currently experiencing homelessness/ runaway **or**
- Enrolled in or aging out of the foster care system **or**
- High School Dropout

# Success Story

At 19, Amare Jenkins graduated from Premier High School at Gallery Furniture on June 1, 2022. Unsure about the industry to pursue and convinced that college wasn't his path, Amare entered the workforce directly to start earning. Guided by his coach, he enrolled in the WorkBase Learning Program at WorkTexas, aiming to gain skills in an office setting while earning.

After his internship, Amare's positive approach resulted in a position at the WorkTexas Training Center. Since November 4, 2022, he's been an Evening and Training Specialist, initially earning \$15 per hour as a full-time team member. Amare has since received a raise and continues to strive for growth. 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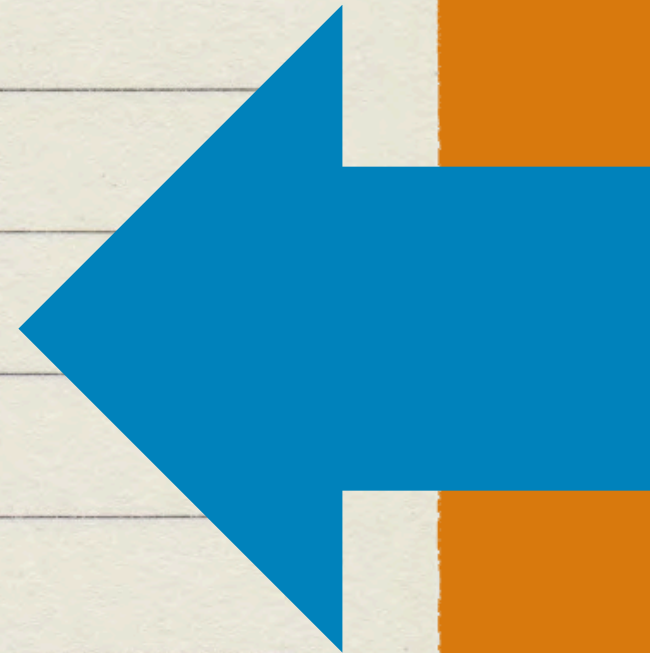
