Role & Responsibilities:

- Understands and supports the mission, vision, and values of WorkTexas.
- Becomes knowledgeable on all existing trainings offerings and programs at WorkTexas as well as eligibility requirements for each.
- Becomes fully knowledgeable of WorkTexas' partner organizations, the population each serves, as well as specific services they provide to make quality referrals.
- Assesses students' interests, supports with completion of training and partner organization applications, handles required documentation, collects information, enters data, and provides excellent customer service.
- Tracks enrollment and referrals to services in Salesforce and monitors progress of referral.
- Responds quickly to questions, issues, and provides detailed information on requirements, processes, and policies.
- Communicates with students and/or family members to provide updates on enrollment or referrals to services, and provides guidance and recommendations as needed.
- Enters, updates, and reviews data electronically and manually.
- Processes enrollments and dis-enrollments.
- Assists with billing and payment processing.
- Conducts information sessions as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.
